PhD Studentship in Analytical Science

Applications are invited for an EPSRC Industrial CASE Studentship in collaboration with BP. The studentship will investigate the application of mass spectrometry and ion mobility spectrometry to surface analysis. The successful candidate will join an active research group in the Centre for Analytical Science, based in the Department of Chemistry.

The studentship is funded for 3.5 years commencing in October 2011 and includes a maintenance grant and tuition fees. Applicants should have, or expect to receive, at least an upper second BSc/MChem degree, or a Masters degree or an equivalent qualification in chemistry or a related area.

Curriculum Vitae will only be accepted if accompanied by a completed application form.
